COUNSELOR APPLICATION

ALL APPLICANTS:

1. Must be a junior, senior, or graduate student of music, art, theatre, dance, or filmmaking or currently employed in the Arts.
 2. Must be in good academic standing.
 3. Must be recommended by the college or university that they attend and the name and telephone number of a faculty member must be included.
 4. Must submit a typed or printed resume detailing work and experience in music, theatre, filmmaking, visual art or dance.
 5. Must submit two (2) recommendation forms one (1) of which must be from a faculty member of college or university which you attend. The other recommendation form may be other faculty member or past employer.
 6. Must be available from June 3, 2021 – June 27, 2021. Orientation will be June 3rd and June 4th. Students arrive June 5, 2021.
 7. Must be willing to make a complete commitment to the requirements and responsibilities of the job as described below.
- Stipend: \$1,300.00 plus room and board.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Counselors live in the dormitory with students and work daily with students, faculty, and staff. Duties include supervising students in the dormitory, helping with student adjustment and discipline, performing various chores in support of daily school operations and productions. A successful counselor must be a mature, sensitive, and responsible person who can maintain rapport with teenagers while at the same time maintaining a position of leadership and supportive authority with them. Counselors must also be able to communicate effectively with faculty and students, and must make an absolute commitment to enforcing school rules and regulations which are designed to create a healthy, safe, and positive learning and living environment for gifted and talented adolescents. Counselors must be available for orientation sessions prior to the start of the School and must be free to stay for the duration of the School term.
